ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION of the Applicant, Beaver Lake Cree Nation, by its Chief and Council (BLCN), without notice, for an injunction; AND UPON reading the Affidavit of Chief Germaine M. Anderson, filed; AND UPON noting the Undertaking as to Damages, filed; AND UPON hearing the submissions of counsel for BLCN; AND UPON CONCLUDING that an interim, interlocutory injunction should be granted pending a further hearing before the Court;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. In this Order, "Authorized Persons" include: Chief Germaine Anderson; Councilor Charlene Cardinal; Councilor Shirley Paradis; Councilor Felix Lewis; the BLCN's

employees, staff and contractors; and members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP).

2. All individuals present on the lands of the Beaver Lake Cree Nation Reserve (the “Lands”), other than Authorized Persons, are hereby temporarily enjoined, restrained and prohibited from:

- a. Changing any locks or instructing others to change any locks on any buildings on the Lands administered by the Chief and Council. For clarity, such buildings include: the Band Administration Office, the Community Hall, the Health Centre, the Treatment Centre, the Public Works Building and the School (collectively referred to as the “Community Buildings”).
- b. Harassing, preventing, interfering with or obstructing any individual from accessing any of the Community Buildings.
- c. Approaching any individual within 50 metres of any Community Building to discourage them from entering, remaining in or returning to any Community Building.
- d. Interfering with the provision of any and all services provided or administered by the Chief and Council on the Lands, including emergency and non-emergency services.
- e. Harassing, preventing, interfering with or obstructing any of the Authorized Persons from discharging their duties and obligations towards the provision of any and all services on the Lands.
- f. Damaging, defacing or erecting signage on any Community Building.
- g. Occupying any Community Building, except for the use of services customarily available to members of the BLCN, in that building at that time, or as otherwise permitted by the Chief and Council.

7. The costs of this Application may be spoken to at a later date.
