**RE: SUPREME COURT OF CANADA HEARING  
ON ADVANCE COSTS**

November 1, 2021 – On November 4, 2021, the Beaver Lake Cree Nation (Nation) will be in the Supreme Court of Canada (SCC). On January 21, 2021, the SCC granted Leave to Appeal the decision of the Alberta Court of Appeal, overturning the Nations' partial advanced cost award. Communique and briefings on this matter, as it unfolded, are available on the Nation website for review.
